



Description: The Pizza Oven is situated at the edge of the central wooded area by the wooden gazebo opposite the Log Cabin.

Learning Outcomes: A great alternative to cooking whilst on the site. Learning another cooking skill while having fun.

Leaders are responsible for reviewing and adding to the Risk Assessment which is recommended to be completed during a site visit. These are to be shared with the Leadership Team.

Girlguiding members: Girlguiding Consent Forms must be completed for any participant under 18 and appropriate Commissioner informed of intended activities

For non-Girlguiding events / users: The hirer must ensure appropriate insurance cover for the activities undertaken and provide evidence if requested by Heyswood Management Committee.

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Burns from Fire or Sparks	All	When group is not using the fire i.e. during safety briefing they are positioned a safe distance away Material should be placed, not thrown, onto the fire Only leaders to tend the fire Clear safety brief to hazards of fire Water bucket for burns Signs warning: 'Caution Hot Surface'	L	Μ	First Aid Kit	Leader
Injury due to slips, trips or falls	Participants	Materials for fire neatly stacked in wood store Trip hazards moved from the fire area No running near fire Appropriate footwear to be worn Reminder of uneven ground and rough vegetation	Μ	м	First Aider and 1 st Aid Kit available	Leader
Food allergies	Participants	All participants asked to identify any allergies or dietary requirements Ensure pizza is hot throughout before serving All food to be stored as recommended until required	L	м	Participants health forms available	Leader
Burns form Hot Food	Participants	Participants reminded that food cooked from the pizza oven is extremely hot Participants educated that the pizza oven surround and cooking paddle is hot Heat proof gloves to be worn when tending the fire or pizza's	L	м	First Aider and 1 st Aid Kit available	Leader
Cuts and splinters	Participants	Adults to supervise the cutting of pizzas and any use of knives	L	м	First Aid Kit	Leader
